PROVIDING CUSTOMIZED AND SUPPLEMENTARY SUPPORT SERVICES

Our goal is to enhance the experience and success of English-speaking individuals seeking employment through local services by providing tailored support, such as:

- Support with forms: completing an employment service request to either Services Québec or a regional employment service provider.

- Translation services: translate, from English to French, a document related to the job search (e.g.: résumé, cover letter, thank-you letter, job application form, letter of recommendation, letter confirming previous employment).
